This quarter our Programs Director Jahanzeb Daudzai and our volunteer Christopher Fitzgerald wrote about how to effectively support children & youth with disabilities & their families in the midst of a humanitarian crisis. Afghanistan has one of the highest proportions of people with disability globally. Children & youth with disability are one of the most disadvantaged groups & face many challenges, but are rarely included in development programs or allowed a voice in programs designed to support them. Supporting children & youth with disability within their homes & communities increases chances of their full participation in society, accessing services & their rights to education & future employment. Working directly w families & communities also helps break down stigma. ECI's community-based disability awareness & support program has supported over 530 children with disabilities & their families in 6 provinces of Afghanistan & provided awareness sessions to 5,000+ women & men.
